The trophies for the State Motorkhana will be presented at the July meeting. If you are a trophy winner and know that you can't make this meeting, please let me know so that alternative arrangements can be made to get your trophy to you.

For those of you involved or interested in rallying, frontal head restraints will become compulsory for competitors in multi-club and club level CAMS rally events from the 1st January 2019 and 2020 respectively. For more information on this, check out the latest Speed Read from CAMS or contact them directly on 1300 883 959.

More news regarding CAMS, Event Organisers are now able to apply for an event permit online. Apparently they have combined the traditional permit application format with supplementary regulations, so applicants will be able to upload basic event details, list key officials, complete a safety first check and upload entry forms, etc. This has been developed to try and reduce the amount of paper work needed to be completed to organise an event. The club would then be invoiced when receiving approved regulations from CAMS. The permit types available through the new changes include all Social, Non-Speed and Speed events, up to and including National Championship level. I personally haven't tried this for a competitive event, but have applied for CAMS social permits for all of my 3 social events in one application and in under 5 minutes which was great! Fingers crossed some of the rest of it works just as easy!

Thinking about going to see the World Rally Championship in Coffs Harbour in November this year? CAMS Members are currently able to access a deal where you can pay for an 'Ultimate Get Me Everywhere' pass for \$99 and you get a second pass for free. Interested in becoming an Official?

To ensure our events run properly and that our regular officials have a chance to also compete, we need more members to obtain officials licences. Thankfully CAMS are making this process easier.

We need all current Trainee officials to upgrade to General officials. This involves officiating for one day and filling out a Trainee form and then completing an online Introductory module. This can be completed in any order. By becoming a General official, it will mean less work for the Event Secretary, but you will also receive a CAMS Officials Licence Book similar to your CAMS Competition Licence Book. Whenever you officiate, this book then gets signed by a member of the organising committee for that event.

This log of events can then be used when upgrading your licence to a Bronze level. It is of note that Bronze level official licences never expire.

TCC really NEED MORE Bronze level Event Admin, Event Command and Scrutineer officials. We simply do not have enough of these in the club to allow members to only officiate in a higher role at one TCC event in a year allowing them to compete in other events.

Just to repeat that Bronze level official licences never expire. For members a little worried about learning and performing these roles, please be assured that we have many members in the club who are happy to mentor you through this process. Help is never far away. Some roles will require you to be actively involved in the organisation of the event so leaving this to the last minute will not benefit yourself with any potential assessments. TCC has plenty of events that you can help run and upgrade your licence, so please have a good think about it and speak to an Executive member in order to start the process.

LOOK BACK.

A Nostalgic roam through past 'Piston Slaps' for the month of July.

1978:

Editor Don Adams wrote about the horrific loss of life over the Queen's Birthday weekend – 28 dead – and the fact that half of these were attributed to drink driving. We had a letter to the Editor from Col Atkinson (of Golf / VW fame) about tests being conducted with some degree of success, on fuel made from wheat extract. We had an offer of Castrol GXT Oil at \$17 + \$1 for the club, for a 20 litre drum.

The mid-year Point Score showed that Garry Russell was leading, hotly pursued by Ernie Boston and John Littler (you really do need another club car John). Janelle Lansley was heading the Ladies while Wendy Maher was 6th.

Competition wise, we had 18 TCC starters at an Oran Park Super Sprint South Circuit. Our fastest was Hans Klaack in his VW – 54.45 seconds. We also had 19 competitors at a motorkhana at the Willows Picnic Grounds near Cattai. Don Adams in a Cooper 'S' was first outright, while Ernie Boston, Tony Dorrough and Garry Russell each won their class. Socially, we had a bowling night at Blacktown Bowl and the only report was that Andy Babb broke his finger.

1983:

Editor Steve Lansley wrote about oil causing skin cancer – in mice! As President, I wrote about the past events, particularly the 74 starters we had at the Queen's Birthday Motorkhana at Leppington. Wendy Maher presented an article about the D.M.T. (remember them?) adopting international road warning signs with the picture and figures of steep descents, children, horses, trains, narrowing roads etc. This was done mainly so that Gary Maher could use them in touring assemblies 20 years later. There was an article from a 'roving reporter' about our hugely successful fancy dress party at the Mahers (see last months' 'Look Back') '.....And then there was Kate'. You had to be there!

John Littler advertised his long-suffering Combi Camper for sale with his usual salesman flair of a half page of crap, while Garry Elliott plugged a Datsun 180 Wagon for \$2995 in a twenty letter ad – including the \$ sign. Garry also advertised a pair of one and a half inch SU Carbies for \$100. I don't suppose you've still got them Garry? I could really use them now – for \$95 of course.

Ernie's cartoons dealt with Steve Lansley grabbing a very live high-tension wire and Ernie's fixation with lights on cars. Sporting wise, we attempted a rally in the Nerong Forest, north of Newcastle, and a motorkhana run by Fiat CC at Ansell Park – no results from either. Socially, we had a bowling night at Hornsby which attracted 28 members. Ken Barnwell top-scored with 166, followed by Steve Lansley on 158.

1988:

There was no Editorial this month (?) Phil Coffey, President wrote thanking everyone who officiated at our State motorkhana and promised to start competing in his Cooper 'S'. Has he really been promising that for 15 years? Craig Burns wrote a very full report on F1 racing from Canada, Detroit and France, while John Radford gave us a wrap of what was going on at CAMS. After reading the report, I decided that nothing had really changed. In the sporting field, we had our state khana at Leppington and a rally at Brooman on the South Coast where only 25 of the 42 starters finished. Five TCC crews started and finished – the best being Garry Elliott & Ray Rowe in, of course, a Subaru. Phil Coffey (with a little help from me) directed a

very successful President's rally – a touring assembly attended by 16 crews. Jim Richardson and Wendy Maher teamed up for this event – and won it!!

1993:

Editor Ray Rowe, dealt with the great roll-up at some past events and thanked a large number of members who had showed support for the magazine by writing articles – where are they all now?

As President, I wrote my page while traveling to Melbourne on the Southern Aurora to pick up our first classic rally car, the Hillman Gazelle. Apart from what was going on around me, the article covered the fact that we had bought our first photocopier for \$900. This was the beginning of a much easier job for the Editor and meant the end of messy old roneo machines forever.

We also reluctantly accepted the resignation, from the Executive, of John Radford due to the fact that he and Kathy were moving to Kurri Kurri. Happily, he has retained his membership and we see them occasionally.

We attended two rallies – one at Wauchope and one at Bulahdelah. There was no report on Wauchope but 6 TCC crews were part of the 32 car field at Bulahdelah – the best being Craig Kenchington and T Coomb who were 5th outright. This was the start of what turned out to be a long and successful career in rallying.

Ernie Boston presented the 'Circuit of Ireland, Fairyland, Fairfield' – a touring assembly with a difference – that difference being Ernie. At the end of the event, John Littler and Bob Davidson tied for 1st place with Wendy and myself and there were several ties for the minor places. Ernie had a solution to this. To decide the winner, he had some motor sport trivia questions. Wendy and I did best – or rather least poorly – and were declared the winners.

There were no motorkhanas at all this month (?) so 'Bits from Boston' dealt at length with the touring assembly – and there were no cartoons either.

2. Proof of current financial membership of TCC supplied
3. Proof of current insurance of vehicle.
4. Current pink slip for vehicle
5. Completed Historical Vehicle Declaration (as supplied with your renewal)
6. A \$10 fee payable to TCC to cover admin costs
7. A signed acceptance of all current conditions and regulations.
